Reference is made to your application dated Pebruary 10, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Wolfcamp and Devonian production on your Dickinson "D" Lease comprising the E/2 W/2, SW/4 NW/4, and NW/4 SW/4 of Section 35, Township 14 South, Range 37 East, Denton Field, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production to each of the pools on the basis of periodic well tests.
