Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated February 14, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Wolfcamp and Glorieta production from your M. E. Hale Lease comprising the SE/4 and E/2 SW/4 of Section 35, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Glorieta production and determining the Wolfcamp production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for a non-reset counter on the meter.
