Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 2, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Drinkard and Blinebry production on your L. G. Marlick Lease comprising the N/2 NG/4 of Section 19, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Drinkard production and determining the Blinebry production by means of the subtraction method.
