RE: Administrative Order FC-214

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of January 28, 1965, wherein you advise that your L. G. Warlick "C" Well No. 3 located in the SE/4 of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, is now capable of top allowable production.

Administrative Order FC-214 permitted the commingling of Blinebry, Brunson, Drinkard, and Hare Simpson production on your L. G. Warlick "C" Lease, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. Inasmuch as you now have top allowable production from the Drinkard Pool, it will be necessary to meter either all Drinkard production or the top allowable production from the Well No. 3.
