Reference is made to your application dated August 24, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Glorieta and San Andres production on your State N Lease comprising the 3/2 NS/4 and Sa/4 NS/4 of Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 35 Last, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Glorieta production and determining the San Andres production by means of the subtraction method.
