Reference is made to your application dated August 28, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard oil on your J. R. Cone "A" Lease comprising the 3/2 SN/4 of Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 37 Mast, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining the Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method.
