Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated October 15, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Fowler-Sevonian and Fowler-Blinbry production on your C. Myers "B" Lease comprising the S/2 of Section 9, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that a field inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.
