Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 9, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of liquids produced from an undesignated Gallup gas pool and the Basin Dakota gas pool by your Northwest Federal Well No. 3-6 located in Unit C of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the gas from each pool will be separately metered and that the only thing to be commingled is the liquid hydrocarbon production. Allocation of the hydrocarbon to each of the separate pools will be made on the basis of periodic gas-oil ratio tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that gas-oil ratio tests shall be conducted monthly on each zone of the subject dual completion.
