ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PC-252 EXCEPTION TO RULE 303 (a) MOBIL OIL CORPORATION'S D. A. WILLIAMSON LEASE DRINKARD & BLINEBRY POOLS LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Gentlemen:

Mobil Oil Corporation respectfully requests that the subject order be amended to provide for the determination of production from each pool from quarterly well tests. The subject order granted Mobil permission to commingle Drinkard and Blinebry production from the D. A. Williamson Well No. 1 after separately metering Drinkard production and determining Blinebry production by means of the subtraction method.

At the time the order was issued the Drinkard completion was top allowable and the Blinebry completion was marginal. Production from the Drinkard has subsequently declined and both pools are now marginal. Average production from the Drinkard pool during November and December 1968 was 8.6 BOPD. Average production from the Blinebry pool during the same period was 9.7 BOPD.

Since both pools are now marginal we believe that this lease is eligible for commingling under the provisions of Section II 1 of the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities".
