Amendment Administrative Order PC-266

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated August 18, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-266 which authorised the commingling of Monument-Tubb and Skaggs-Drinkard on your E. H. B. Phillips B Lease in Section 10, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately measuring the Monument-Tubb production and determining the Skaggs-Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that production from both some has declined to marginal status and that you therefore propose to allocate the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-266 is hereby amended to delete the requirement for separate measurement of one of the zones, provided, however, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in either of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.
