Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated July 2, 1965, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of distillate produced from the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Gas Pools from your Bunny et al Well No. 1 located in the SE/4 of Section 10, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the condensate production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
