RE: REQUEST FOR EXCEPTION TO RULE 303 (a) AND 309-A, STATE BRIDGES LEASE, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

Gentlemen:

Under the provisions of Rule 303 (b), permission is herewith requested to commingle into common storage the production from the Vacuum Blinebry, Vacuum Glorieta, Vacuum North Abo, Vacuum Wolfcamp and Vacuum Upper Penn Pool production from Socony Mobil Oil Company's wells drilled in Section 25, T-17-S, R-34-E, of the State Bridges Lease, Lea County, New Mexico. The acreage in the requested area consists of the N/2 of the NE/4, the SW/4 of the NE/4 and the NW/4 of Section 25, T-17-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The royalty and working interest are common, the State of New Mexico owning the former and the Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc. operating the latter. All the acreage in the lease in Section 25 is contiguous.

The following exhibits are attached:

Exhibit I - Location plat showing the area involved (outlined in red) and the wells involved (color coded).

Exhibit II - A schematic diagram of the proposed commingling installation.

Exhibit III - Detailed data concerning gravity, volumes and value of crude oil.

You will note that we propose to locate the commingling installation in Section 26, T-17-S, R-34-E. The pipeline which services this area already has their gathering system terminated at the proposed location in Section 26. It would be a definite economic and operating advantage to them if they did not have to extend the gathering system. Also, Socony Mobil already has temporary equipment on the proposed site which lends

itself to the proposed commingled installation. One central location for operation will be an advantage to Socony Mobil in operating expenses as well as a savings by not having to move presently installed equipment.

There will be no commingling of production from Section 25 of the State Bridges Lease with the rest of the State Bridges Lease and there will be no intercommunication of the handling, separating, treating or storage facilities designated to each account. Upon approval, the commingling installation will be operated in accordance with the provisions of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission 'Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities.'




