Gentlemen:

We hereby request an exception to Rule 303 (a) and administrative approval to commingle the production from the Blinebry and Tubb-Drinkard zones from the captioned well. The well is dually completed from the Justis Blinebry and Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pools.

The production from each zone will be approximately 59 barrels per day which is top allowable. Both zones have a proration factor of 1.33. The corrected gravity of each zone is 36-37 and a value of \$2.83 per barrel. The commingled production is expected to be 138 barrels per day of 36-37 gravity oil with a value of \$2.83 per barrel.

The value of the commingled production will not be less than the sum of the values of the production from the separate zones. The ownership of both zones is identical and none of the land involved is State or Federal.

The liquid hydrocarbon production from each zone will be measured or determined prior to such commingling in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

To support this request, attached is a schematic diagram of the proposed installation and a plat of the lease.




