Your letter of February 28, 1966, requests permission to commingle in common surface facilities, the liquid condensate from the Undesignated Mississippian gas pool and the Table Mesa Pennsylvanian "C" gas pool, from well No. 29, SE\nE\struct sec. 9, T. 27 N., R. 17 W., and well No. 18, SE\struct NV\struct sec. 3, T. 27 N., R. 17 W. on Navajo Indian lease I-89-Ind-57, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The method you propose for allocating condensate production by periodic gas-oil ratio tests is satisfactory to this office. Form 9-361, Lessee's Monthly Report of Sales and Royalty, must show all computations used in the calculations of condensate attributable to each well.
