Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated February 11, 1966, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard production on your New Mexico State "S" Lease comprising the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 10, and the N/2 N/2 of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Drinkard production and determining the Blinebry production by means of the subtraction method. We are now in receipt of a letter of consent to the proposed commingling from the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made before it is put in operation.
