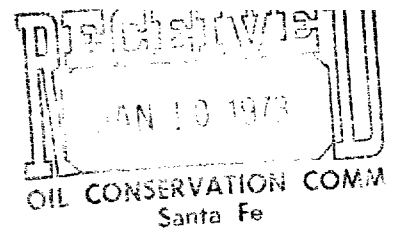



This is to advise that Texaco Inc. has initiated drilling operations for eight (8) injection wells and seven (7) producing wells in its Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Pressure Maintenance Project as authorized by Commission Order No. R-4442 dated November 27, 1972.

As the subject producing wells are completed, Texaco will continue the present commingling of separate lease production into a common tank battery, which was authorized by the Commission's Administrative Order CTB-73 dated December 8, 1961, for leases both inside and outside of the pressure maintenance project.




