Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your applications dated June 10, 1966, for administrative authority to commingle Dakota and Mesaverde condensate produced from several wells in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, allocating the condensate production, if any, back to each zone in each well on the basis of periodic tests. It is our understanding that the ownership of each zone in each well is common.

Caulkins Oil Company is hereby authorized to commingle the Dakota and Mesaverde condensate in the above-described manner which is produced from the following wells:
