Please cancel Administrative Order PC-311 dated October 20, 1966 to commingle Drinkard and Penrose-Skelly production on the W. H. Turner Lease.

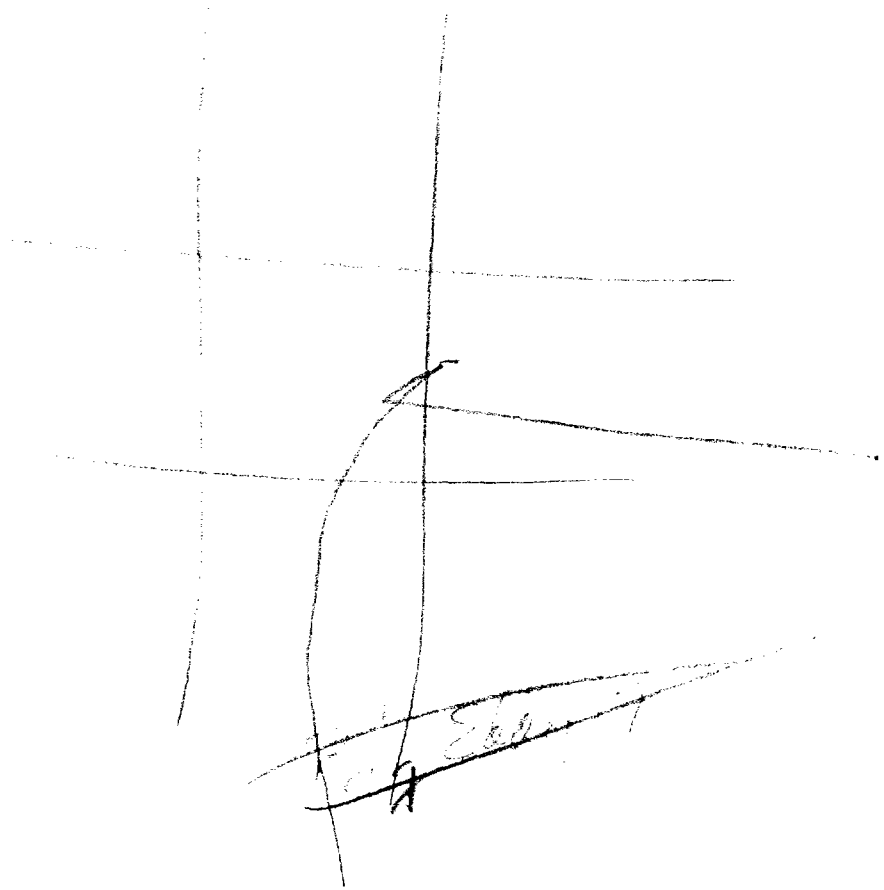
