Gentlemen:

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Reference is made to your letter of November 16, 1966, requesting authority to commingle Table Mesa Dakota oil and condensate from the Table Mesa Pennsylvanian "C" Gas Pool and from an undesignated Mississippian gas pool on your Table Mesa Navajo Lease after separately metering the combined Pennsylvanian and Mississippian production and the Dakota production. It is our understanding that this separate measurement is necessitated by a difference in working interest ownership between the Dakota formation and the other two formations. Determination of liquid production from the combined Pennsylvanian and Mississippian formations will be on the basis of periodic well tests.

By authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
