Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 14, 1967, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Ellenburger and Granite Wash production on your Ella Drinkard Lease which comprises the N/2 NW/4, SW/4 NW/4, and NW/4 SW/4 of Section 25, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, East Brunson Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Ellenburger production and determining the Granite Wash production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made prior to putting it in use.
