Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated August 20, 1968, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Wolfcamp and Devonian production on your V. Linam Lease comprising the W/2 of Section 14, Township 13 South, Range 38 East, Bronco Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from the Wolfcamp formation and determining the Devonian production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission of this installation in order that an inspection may be made of same, although it is our understanding that it has been put into operation in accordance with verbal approval from this office.
