
Gentlemen:

Mobil Oil Corporation respectfully requests that Administrative Order PC-362, dated October 29, 1968, be amended so as to permit the comingling of production from the aforementioned pools by determining the production from each well and each pool by well tests conducted periodically as the Commission may prescribe.

As shown on the attached tabulation of production for the months August 1970 and September 1970, the average daily production for all zones except the Vacuum Upper Pennsylvanian is considerably below top unit allowable. All connected wells, except one in the Vacuum Upper Penn., are now incapable of producing top unit allowable. Mobil proposes to continue to measure the Vacuum Upper Penn. production separately.

The royalty ownership of all comingled zones is identical. Should any further information be required, please advise.




Mobil Oil Corporation respectfully requests that Administrative Order PC-362, dated October 29, 1968, be amended so as to permit the commingling of production from the afore-mentioned pools for certain wells in Sections 10, 12 and 15 in addition to Sections 11, 13, 14 and 23, T17S, R34E, Lea County, New Mexico, as described in the original Administrative Order PC-362.

We further request that the December 17, 1970 Amendment to Administrative Order PC-362 be further amended so as to delete the metering requirement on the Upper Pennsylvanian production and that the commingled production be allocated to each well in each pool by quarterly well tests as presently prescribed for the other producing zones.

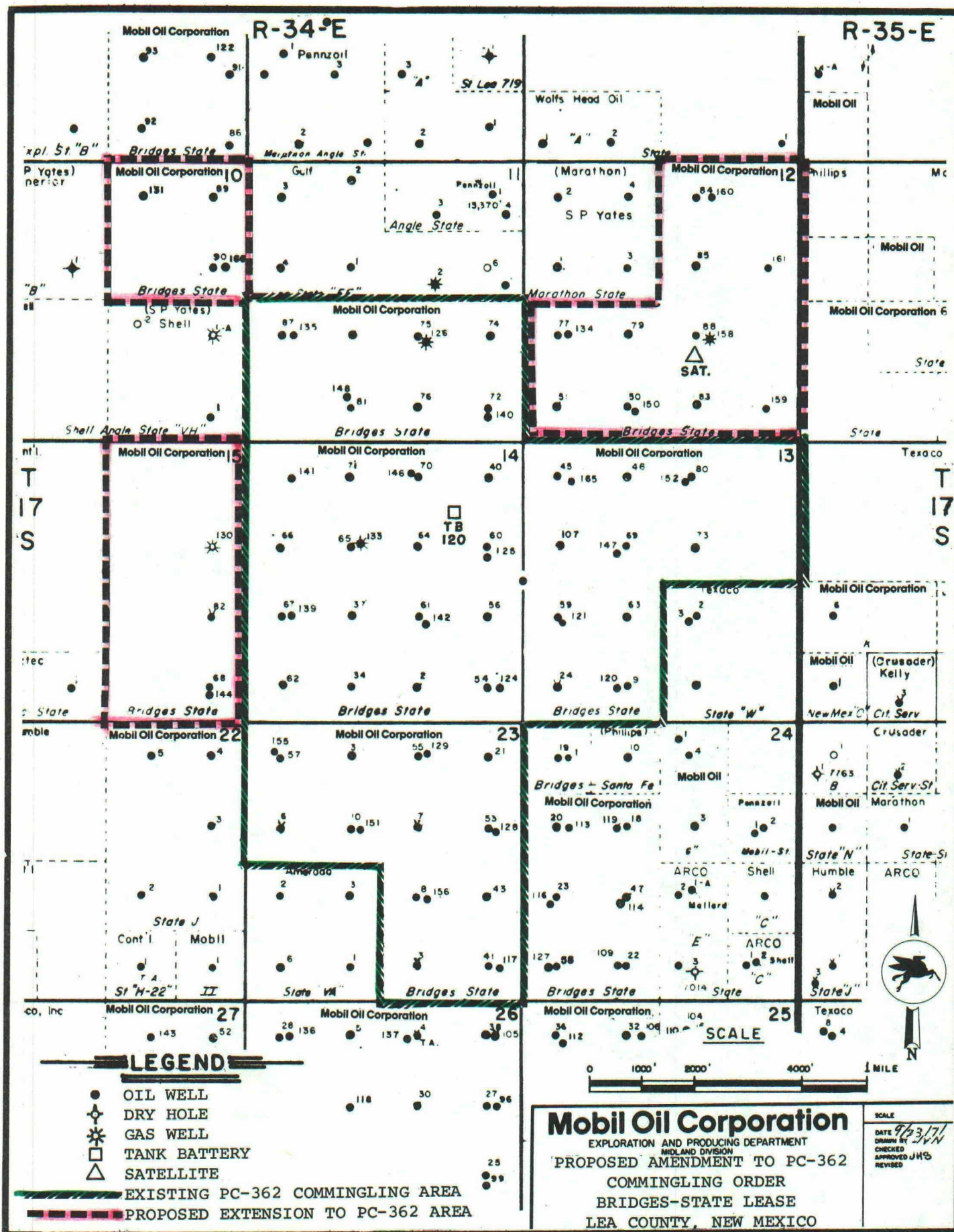
As shown on the attached tabulation of production for the months June 1971 and July 1971, the average daily production for all of the commingled zones is below top unit allowable.

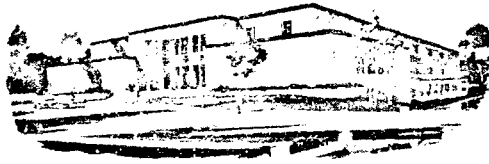
