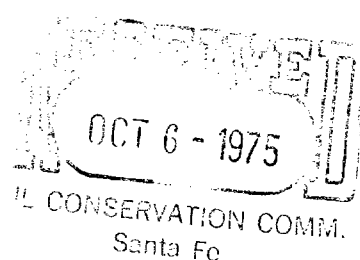

Please cancel Administrative Order PC-392 dated 11-19-69 covering the authority for Amoco Production to commingle Lusk Strawn and Lusk-Delaware production from the Plains Unit Federal Lease wells located in Sections 28, 21 and 33 of Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Lusk Strawn production operations were assumed by Llano, Inc. of Hobbs, New Mexico on 10-1-75.
