By this letter of Application, Getty Oil Company respectfully requests Administrative Approval for the exception to Rule 303 and 309, and permission to commingle oil production on its W. D. Grimes Lease in the Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres and Hobbs Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico by Monthly Well Tests. In support of this Application, Getty Oil Company submits the following information:


By Administrative Order PC-401 dated April 10, 1970, commingling of the oil production from the Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres and Hobbs Drinkard Pool was authorized.

Attachment I is a schematic of the present commingling facilities.

Getty Oil Company requests approval to alter the commingled facilities as follows and submits the following proposal:

1. Attachment II is a schematic of the proposed commingling facilities.
2. Continue to produce into a single oil sales system as is presently being done.
3. All wells producing on the W. O. Grimes Lease are Marginal Producers; therefore, the zone meter is not required.
4. Allocate the Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres and Hobbs Drinkard production by Monthly Well Tests.

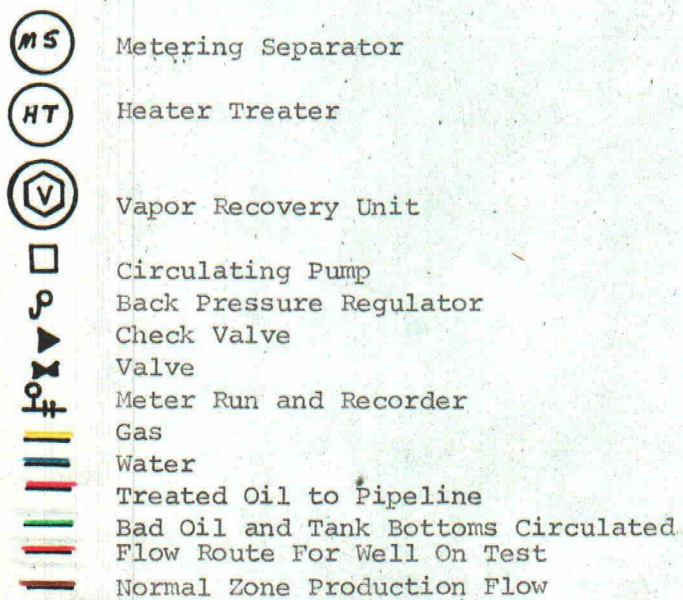
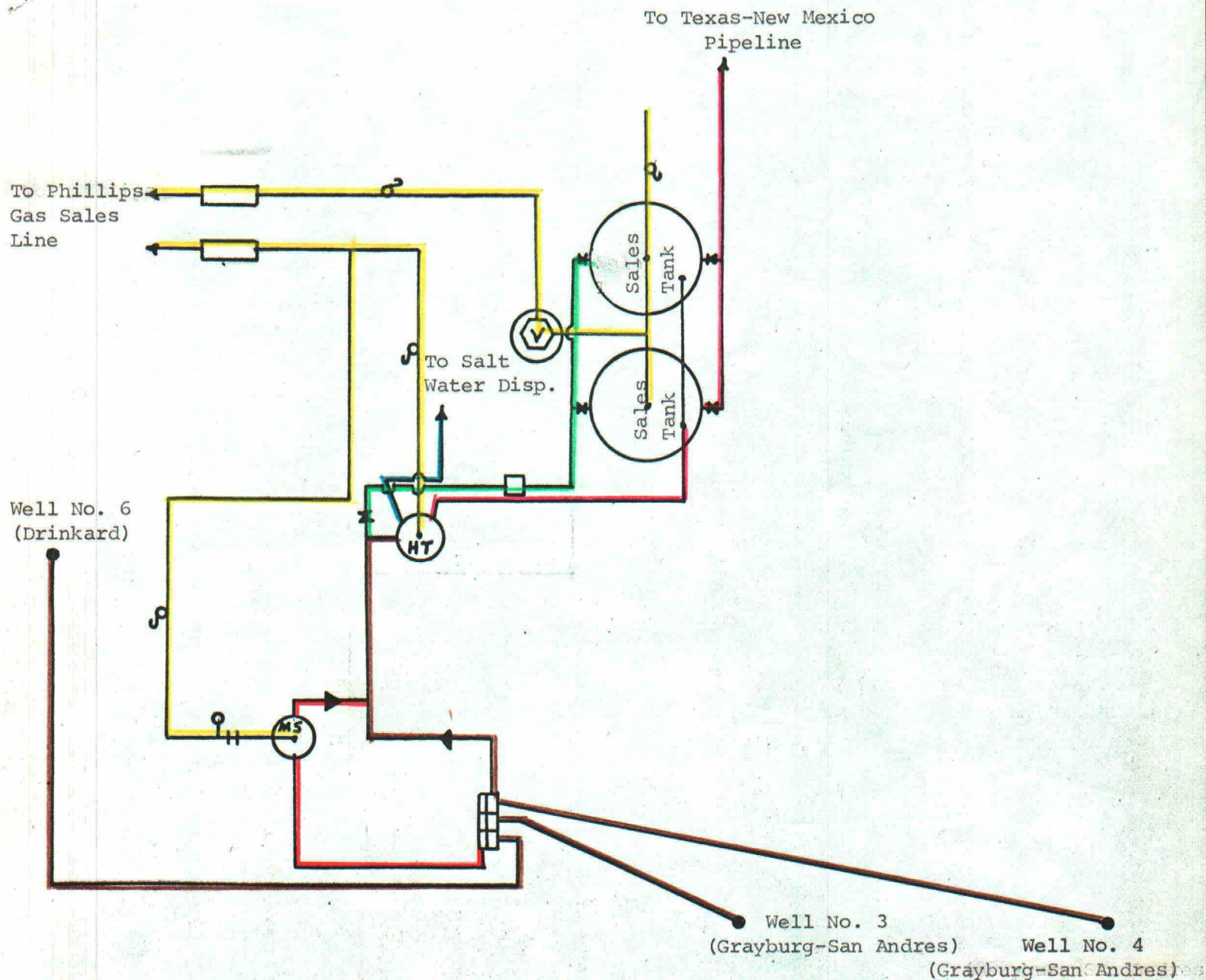
