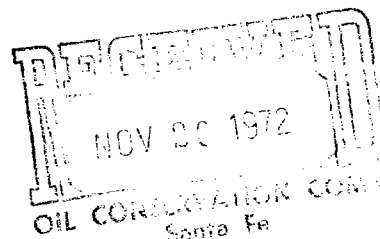

Gentlemen:

Your letter of October 13, 1972, requested approval to commingle on the surface oil production from certain wells on Jicarilla lease Contract No. 64 in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

You are hereby granted approval to commingle on the surface oil production from wells No. 2, 3, and 4 (Undesignated Gallup Pool) with production from the No. 5 well which produces from the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Pool. Such approval is subject to periodic testing of individual wells to determine the amount of production from each well. This approval will automatically terminate if assignments are made such that a communitization agreement for either Gallup or Dakota spacing units becomes necessary.

Your schematic diagram of the surface production facilities indicates that a LACT unit has been installed to measure oil sales. This is to advise that LACT unit measurement must be approved by this office. Your request for approval of this special manner of measurement should be accompanied by a description and diagrams of the installation.

Please advise if you have installed LACT units on any other Federal or Indian leases without approval.
