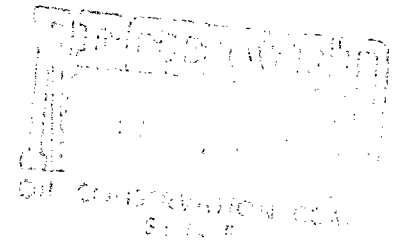

Commingling Order PC-455

Gentlemen :

It is requested that the subject order, which permits commingling of Vacuum Field production from the Grayburg-San Andres and Glorieta Pools on Chevron's State 6-34 lease, be amended to specify metering of Glorieta production and determination of Grayburg-San Andres production by subtraction.

Glorieta production is from only one well, State 6-34 No. 11, with a 2-3 BOPD capacity. Grayburg-San Andres production, on the contrary, is from 5 wells with 350 BOPD capacity. Any error in metering the larger volume would, of course, induce a substantial percentage error in the Glorieta production.

It is further requested that applicable rules regarding specifications for and monthly proving of the metering device be waived on the grounds that production does not warrant the additional expense. This would be consonant with the spirit of Section II, Paragraph 1, of the Manual for Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities. We have considered possibilities for increasing production from the Glorieta in State 6-34 No. 11, have concluded such to be impractical, and have tentatively decided to shut the well in at the occurrence of the next major expense.

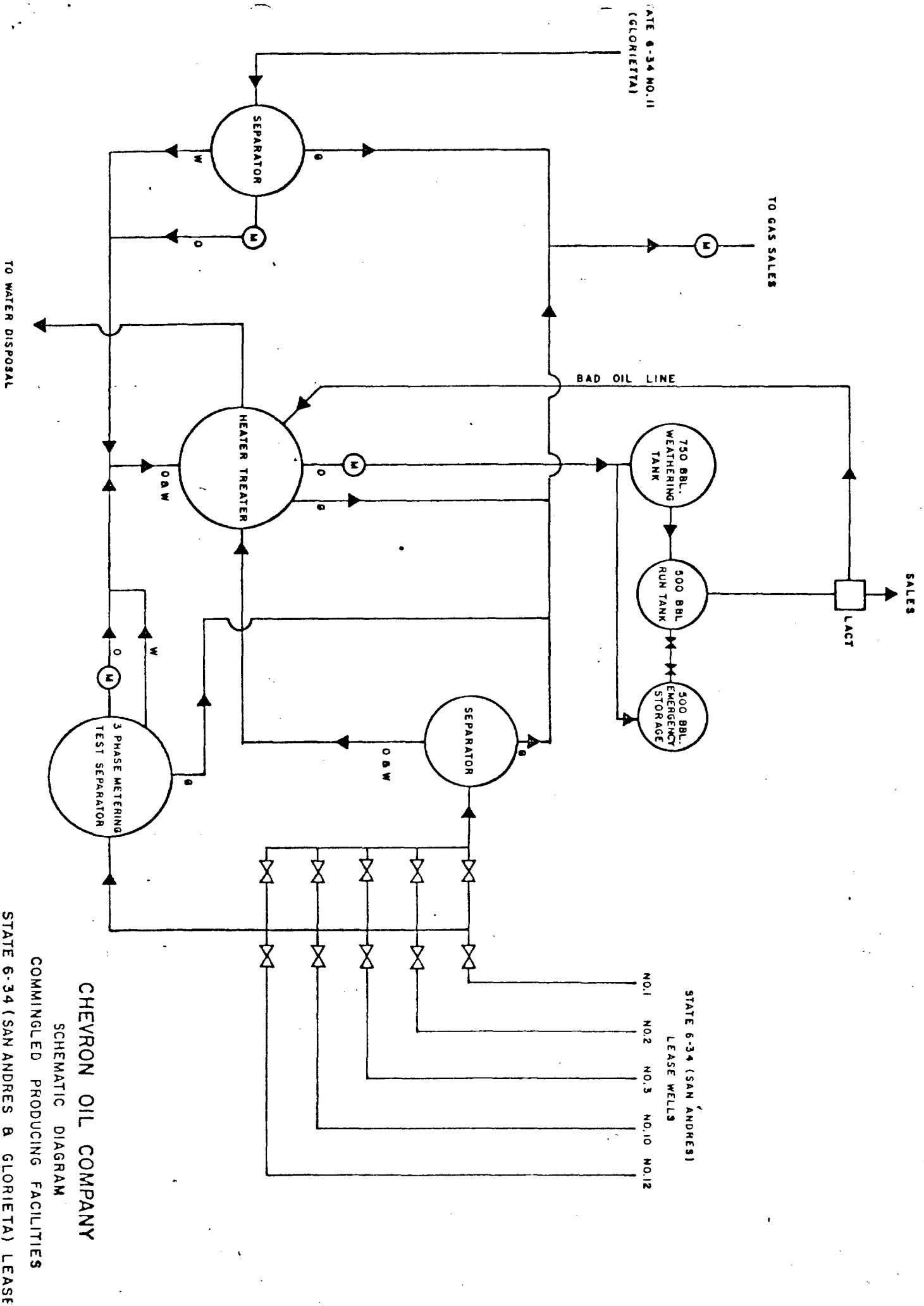
