Application is herewith made for administrative approval to commingle the production from our MATKINS NO. 1, LANGLIE-MATTIX 7 RIVERS QUEEN POOL and our MATKINS NO. 2, JALMAT POOL.

Production from each well averaged 2 BOPD for the month of September, 1973, and 2.12 BOPD for the month of October, 1973. Indicated gravity is  $30^{\circ}$  for both wells.
