Exxon Company, U.S.A., as operator, is hereby making application for an exception to Rule 303-A to permit commingling in common facilities at the South Four Lakes Unit in Lea County.

This unit produces from both the Penn and Devonian formations. The Penn production averages 28 BOPD at 50 degrees gravity and the Devonian production averages 20 BOPD at 53 degrees gravity. We expect no significant gravity and value differences from the commingling of these streams.

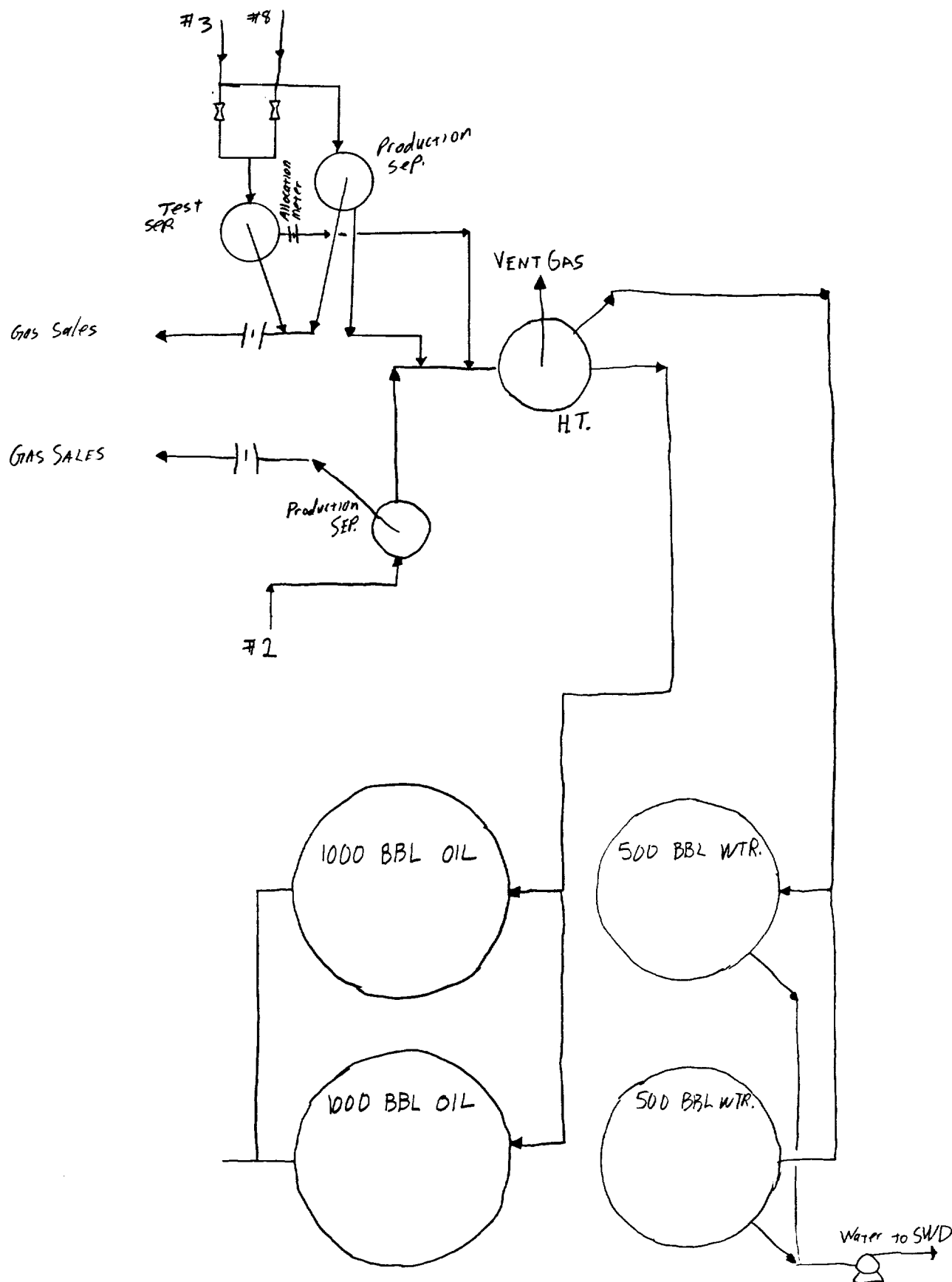

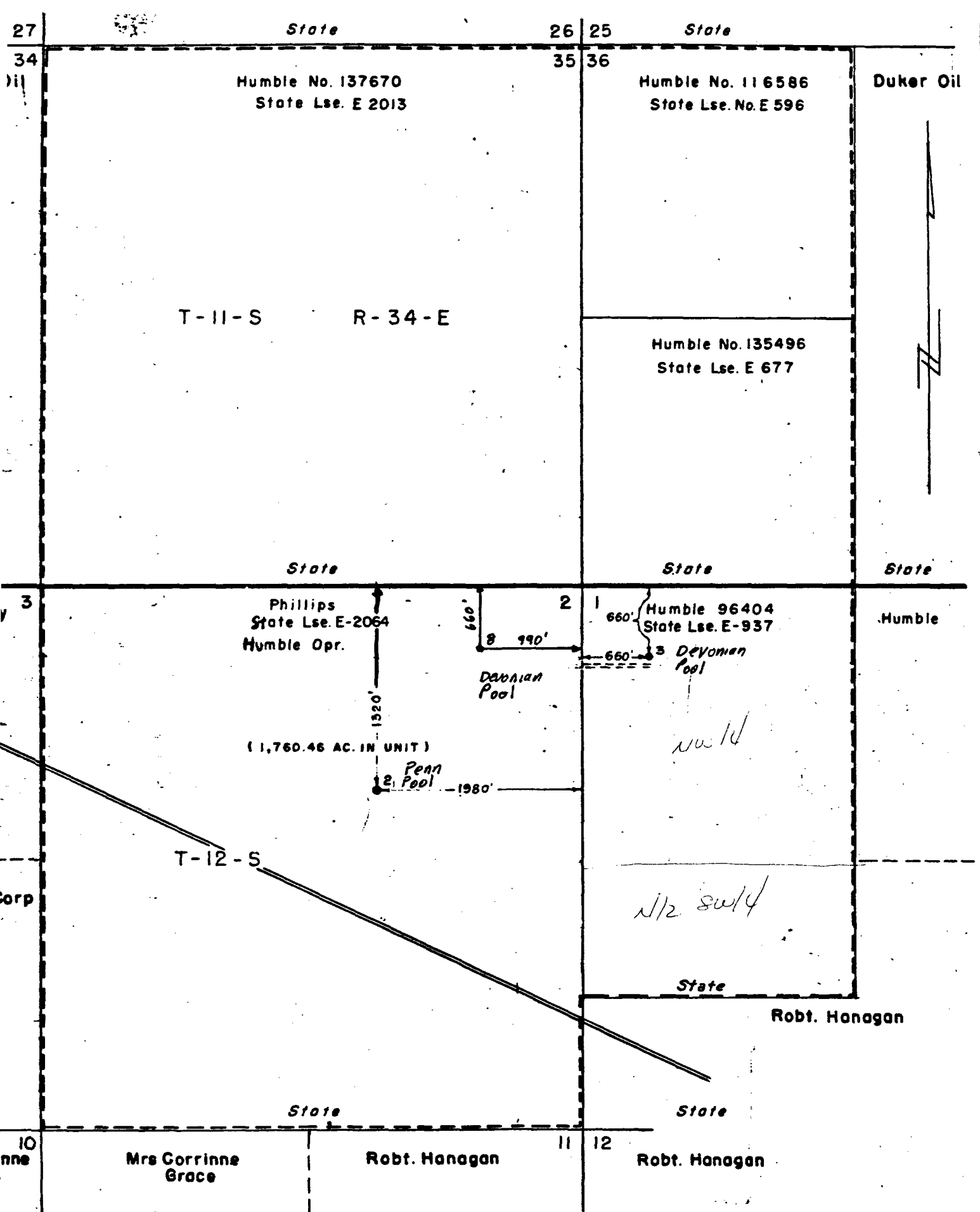
