

Amendment
Administrative Order PLC-4


Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated October 11, 1976, requesting the amendment of Administrative Order PLC-4 to delete the metering requirements thereof.

Administrative Order PLC-4, dated July 9, 1963, and as amended August 7, 1963, May 18, 1964, September 4, 1964, and November 5, 1964, authorizes the commingling of Abo, Blinbry, Glorieta, Wolfcamp, Pennsylvanian, and Devonian production from your State "CG" (NCT-1), "CG" (NCT-2), "L", "M", "N", "O", and "U" Leases, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

It is our understanding that all of the aforesaid production is now of marginal nature, and Texaco is therefore hereby authorized said production in a common tank battery allocating same to the various pools and leases on the basis of at least quarterly tests.
