Reference is made to your application dated December 31, 1963, wherein you request authority to commingle Goodwin-Abo and Goodwin-Drinkard production from your Goodwin "30" Lease and State GG-30 Lease, comprising the NW/4 and W/2 NE/4 of Section 30 and the SW/4 of Section 30, respectively, Township 18 South, Range 37 East, after separately metering the production from each zone and from each lease prior to commingling.

Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. You are also requested to notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that a field inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in use.
