Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated July 21, 1964, wherein you request authority to commingle West Dollarhide Drinkard, Fusselman, and Ellenburger production on your Mexico "J" and "L" Leases comprising the S/2 of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, and the N/2 of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 38 East, respectively, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. It is our understanding that the ownership of each lease is identical throughout and that the production will be allocated to the respective leases on the basis of periodic tests.

Pursuant to the authority granted me under the provisions of Rules 303 (b) and 309-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools and leases in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. You are also requested to notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in use.

Gentlemen:

Skelly Oil Company herein makes application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 to permit the commingling of similar crudes of the West Dollarhide Drinkard, Fusselman and Ellenburger on Company's Mexico "J" and "L" Leases.

In support of this application Skelly states the following:

1. That the applicant is the operator of its Mexico "J" Lease, S/2 Section 32-T24S-R38E and its Mexico "L" Lease, N/2 Section 5-T25S-R38E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. That the attached Exhibit No. 1 is a plat of the Mexico "J" and "L" Leases, the wells in the Drinkard, Fusselman and Ellenburger zones flow lines and proposed location of commingling site.
3. That the working interests and royalty ownership under the above described leases is the same.
4. That the applicant proposes to commingle the production from all the wells, on both leases, producing from the West Dollarhide Drinkard, Fusselman and Ellenburger into one common storage facility as shown on Exhibit No. 2.
5. That the producing properties of the leases are as follows:

Commingled gravity is estimated to be 39.5 degrees worth \$2.99/bbl. The up-grading of the gravities would increase the monthly income from these leases.

6. That the production from each zone will be accurately metered prior to being commingled.
7. That this commingling system will be installed and operated in accordance with OCC's "Manual For Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities".
8. That two of the wells to be commingled are at top allowable - Mexico "L" No. 11 and 24 (Fusselman Zone) and that none of the other wells are top allowable wells restricted by GOR.

Applicant further requests that the production be allocated in accordance with individual well tests to be taken every 6 months.

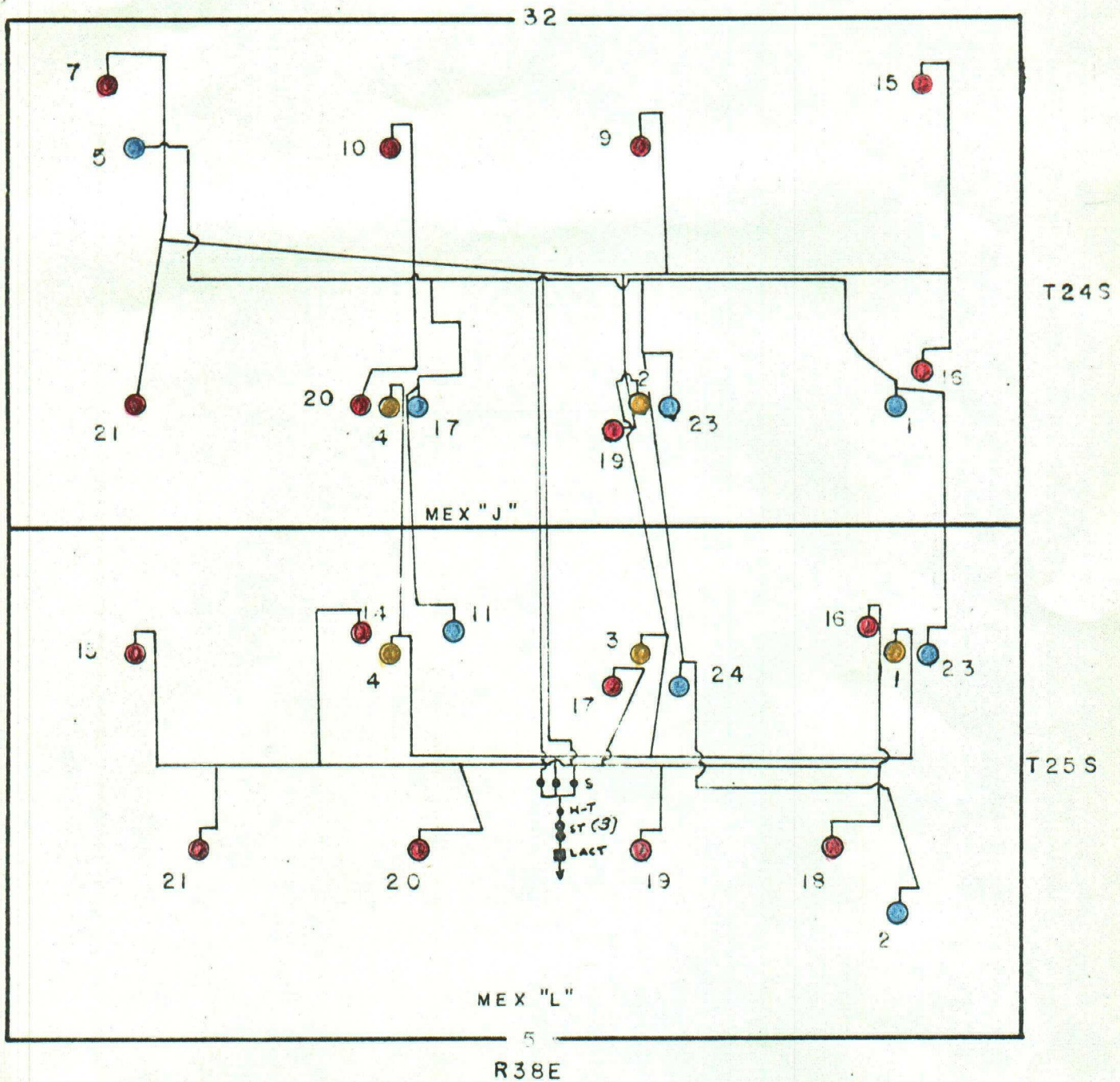

COMMINGLING SYSTEM

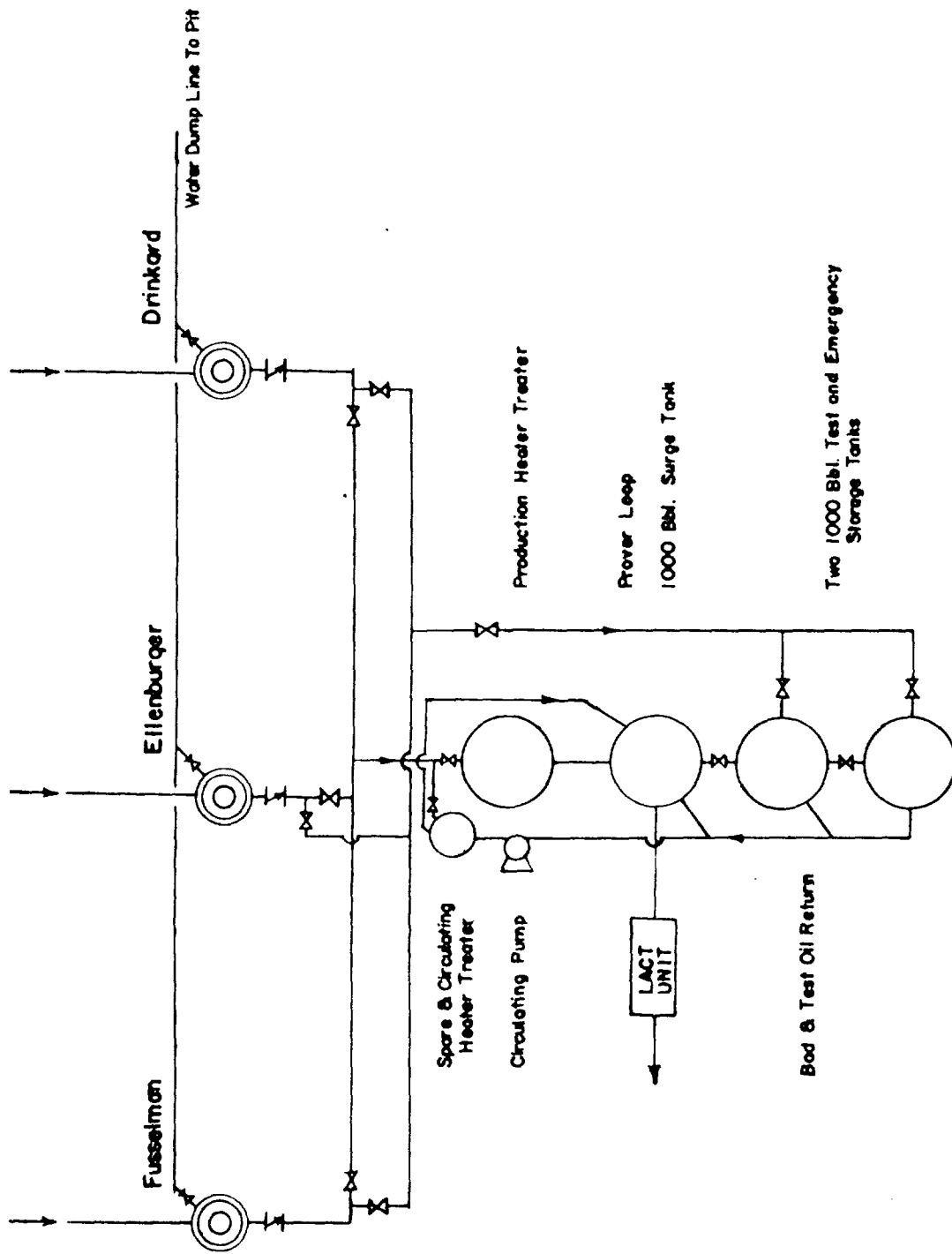


- WEST DOLLARHIDE DRINKARD


