Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of September 24, 1964, wherein you request authority to commingle Vacuum San Andres and Vacuum Yates production in your Tank Battery #5 located in the Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexice. The production would be from the following leases: State Lease No. B-1497 comprising the S/2 SW/4 of Section 27; State Lease No. B-1608 comprising the N/2 NE/4 of Section 33; State Lease No. B-2073 comprising the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 33; and State Lease No. B-2519 comprising the NE/4 of Section 34, all in Township 17 South, Range 35 East. It is our understanding that the Vacuum Yates production will be separately metered and the Vacuum San Andres production determined by means of the subtraction method. Further, that the ownership of each of the four leases is identical throughout and will be allocated to each of the leases on the basis of periodic well tests.

Pursuant to the authority granted me under the provisions of Rules 303 (b) and 309-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools and leases in the abovedescribed manner. Frovided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. You are also requested to notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that a field inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in use.

The 40-acre tracts in Battery No. 5 were described in the Order as follows:

A schematic diagram is attached showing the present equipment and testing facilities at Battery No. 5, and a plat showing the location of the wells and battery is attached.




