Dear Mr. Nutter:

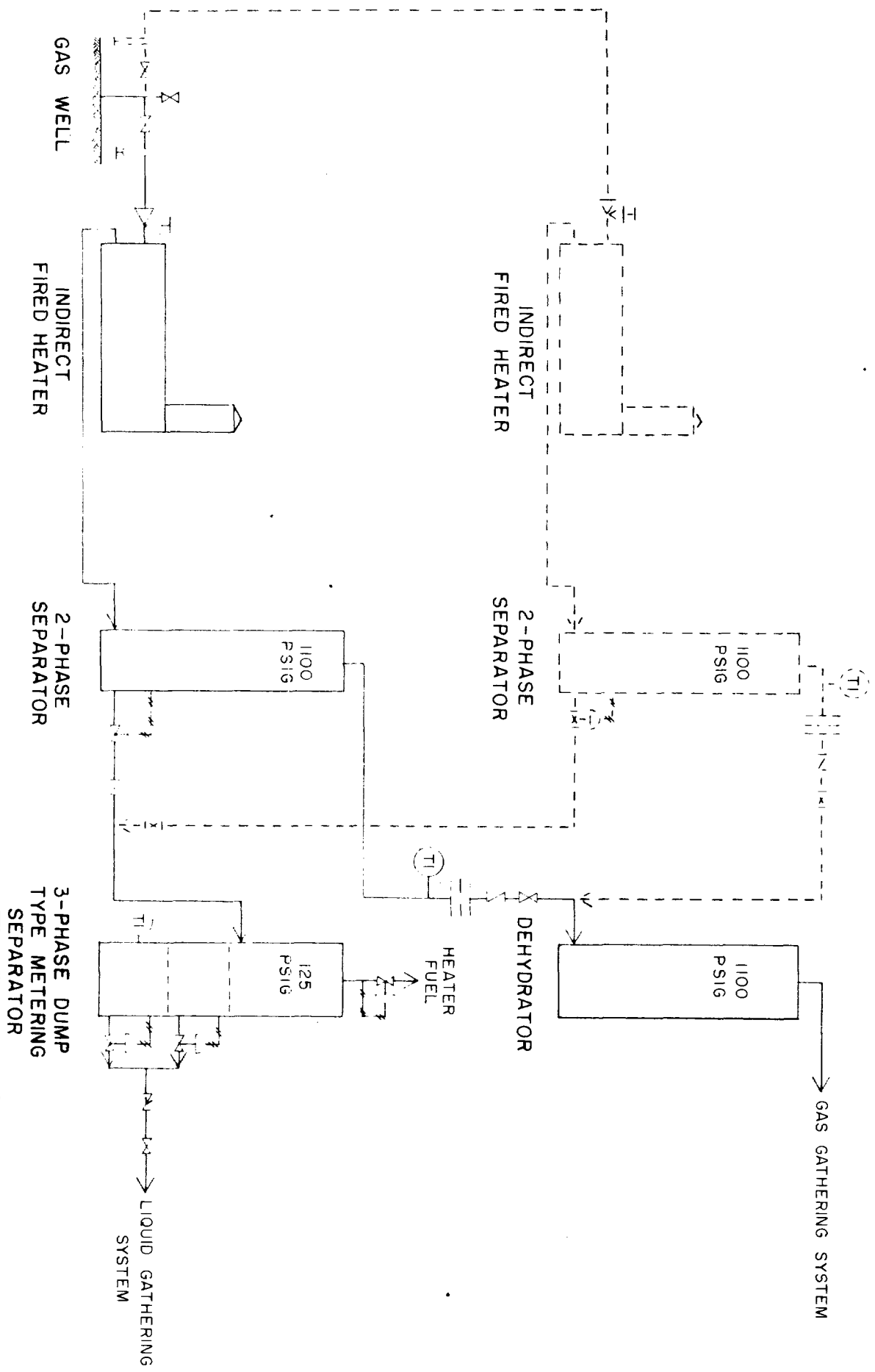
Please refer to my letter to you of April 15, 1965, concerning the above subject. Subsequent to that letter, we discussed this problem by telephone, and you stated that you could not approve the commingling of the raw gas on the lease prior to measurement as we proposed in the operation of dual wells in this field since these pools were to be pro-rated. Therefore, our engineers reviewed this problem, and we have determined that a revision of the lease facilities could be made economically to resolve your objection. Enclosed are two copies of a plat showing the revised lease facilities which we now propose to use in operating dual wells.

Please advise me if the revised facilities are now satisfactory or if you have any further questions.
