Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 6, 1968, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PLC-27 to permit the commingling of Empire-Abo production from your Trigg Federal Lease comprising the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 34, Township 17 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, with the Empire-Abo and Empire-Paddock production from the various leases authorized for commingling by said Order PLC-27. It is our understanding that the production from the Trigg Federal Lease will be metered and sampled prior to commingling as is all production from each lease and each pool producing into this storage system.

Pan American Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized to commingle Empire-Abo production from the Trigg Federal Lease with the Empire-Abo and Empire-Paddock production from the following leases:

Gentlemen:

Administrative Order PLC-27 authorizes the commingling of oil production from various Federal leases producing from the EMPIRE Abo and EMPIRE Paddock oil pools into the EMPIRE ABO Storage System III.

Pan American respectfully requests that Order PLC-27 be amended to provide for the inclusion of the TRIGG Federal lease, (Fed Lease #LC-064050-A), located in the SE/4 of SE/4 of Section 34, T-17-S, R-27-E, NMPM, EMPIRE Abo Oil Pool, Eddy, County, New Mexico.

Production from the TRIGG Federal will be metered and sampled prior to commingling. The installation of the temperature compensated meter, sampler, non-reset counter, etc., shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

By commingling into the EMPIRE Abo Storage System III, the necessity of a separate salt water disposal line from the well to the Empire Abo Salt Water Disposal System will be eliminated.

There will be no increase or decrease in the actual commercial value of the oil after commingling. Gravities of all Abo crude is comparative and constitutes over 99.5% of all oil moved through this System.

All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production have been notified of our intention by "Certified Mail".




