The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Pearsall Queen and Maljamar Grayburg San Andres pool production from the following leases:

Lease Name: Pearsall "A" Description: N/2 and SE/4 of Sec. 33, T-17-S, R-32-E

Lease Name: Pearsall BX Description: NE/4 NE/4 and S/2 NE/4 of Sec. 34, T-17-S, R-32-E, NMPM, both in Lea County

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: Order No. PC-549 previously approving the commingling of Pearsall Queen and Maljamar Grayburg San Andres pool production on the Pearsall BX Lease and Order CTB-183 which authorized commingling of Queen production from the Pearsall A and Pearsall AX Leases are hereby rescinded.

Application for Permission to Surface Commingle Production from the Pearsall A Lease with Production from the Pearsall BX Lease.

Conoco Inc. requests approval to surface commingle production from the Pearsall Queen Zone on the Pearsall A Lease with production from the Pearsall BX Lease. Please note Administrative Order CTB-183, approved April 8, 1968, provided approval to surface commingle production from the Pearsall A Lease and Pearsall AX Lease; however, the Pearsall AX Lease is no longer productive.

The Pearsall BX Battery currently handles production from Pearsall BX No. 2, which produces from the Pearsall Queen Zone, and Pearsall BX No.  $\hat{3}$ , which is completed in the Maljamar (Grayburg-San Andres) Zone. Commingling Order PC-549 provided approval from the Commission to surface commingle production from these two wells.

Conoco's working interest in the Pearsall A and Pearsall BX Leases is 100 percent. The royalty interest is also common between the leases, but the overriding royalty interest differs. Therefore, production from each lease will be measured separately.


In addition, the attached letter to Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line Company will serve as notification to the purchaser of our commingling proposal.
