Gentlemen:

The R. Olsen Oil Company has recently recompleted its Danglade #2 in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 13-22S-37E as a Blinebry gas well. At the present time we plan to dedicate 80 acres, consisting of the S/2 SE/4 of Section 13-22S-37E to subject well and respectfully request approval for a non-standard 80-acre proration unit. The following facts are offered in support of this application:

1. R. Olsen Oil Company is the owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Danglade.
2. R. Olsen Oil Company's Danglade #2 well located 660 feet from the South and East lines of Section 13, Township 22 South, Range 37 East was recompleted as a Blinebry gas well on April 6, 1957. Subject well formerly produced oil from the Drinkard oil pool, however the Drinkard formation has been sealed off by a plug at 6050 feet. The Blinebry zone, from which the well is now producing, is perforated from 5435 to 5500 feet.
3. R. Olsen Oil Company contends that the proposed unit does not exceed 2640 feet in length; that all acreage within the proposed unit is reasonably proven for Blinebry gas; that the proposed unit consists of contiguous acreage and that the unit lies wholly within the boundaries of a governmental quarter section.

By copy of the attached letter, all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well have been notified of the intention of the R. Olsen Oil Company to form the proposed non-standard gas

proration unit and have been asked to sign waivers in the event they have no objections to the formation of the described unit.

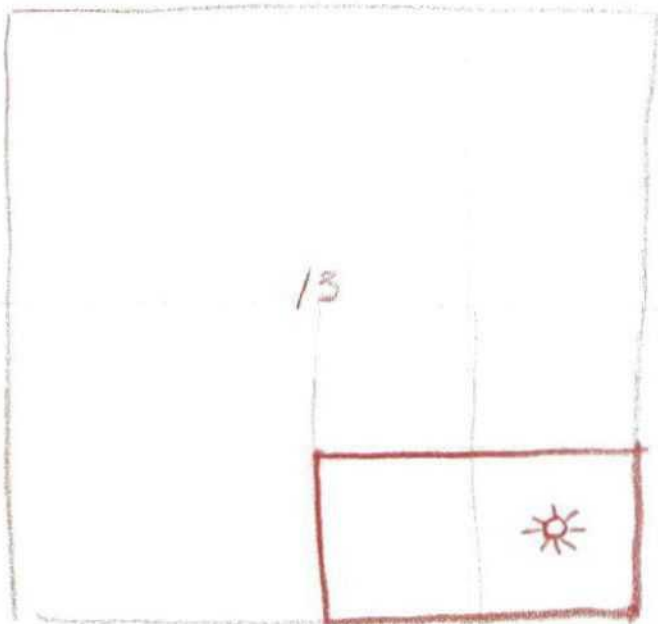
