The Ohio Oil Company respectfully requests that you grant this application for authority to dually complete its lam. H. Turner Well No. 2, located 1980' FSL and 330' FEL, Section 28, T-21S, R-10E, The lam. H. Turner Well No. 3 was originally completed on October 1, 1948, as an oil well producing from the Haro Oil Pool. In June, 1956, the well was plugged back and recompleted as a single completion gas well producing from the Blinberry Gas Pool. The Ohio Oil Company now desires to dually complete the well in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tubbs Gas Pool through the tubing and gas from the Blinberry Gas Pool through the production casing-tubing annulus. Ohio intends to install an efficient packer between the two zones and to perform the completion so as to prevent waste in each reservoir. A schematic diagram showing the proposed method for dually completing the well is attached. Subsequent to the completion, this well is to be presented to the Commission with data showing the detail completion of the well as plans for future testing which will be made regularly to determine that waste is not occurring in either reservoir.

The Ohio Oil Company further respectfully requests that you grant this application for the approval of the unorthodox location of the well stated above and for the designation and formation of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the NW/2 of SE/4, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, Tubb Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The Ohio owns the well and gas leasehold estate on the acreage included in proposed gas proration unit, and the well to be drilled is located in the Blinnhorn and Tubb Gas Pools.

July 2, 1957

New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order NSL-33, dated May 20, 1956, approved an unorthodox well location for the Tubb Well No. 1, located 1980' FSL and 340' PSL, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, Blinberry Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico; and New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order NSP-268, dated May 29, 1956, approved an unorthodox non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinberry Gas Pool consisting of the N/2 of SE/4, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

All acreage included in the proposed gas proration unit is reasonable, presumed to be productive of gas from the Tubb Gas Pool. It is impractical to pool the Ohio leasehold estate with adjoining acreage. Unless the proposed gas proration unit is formed, Ohio will be deprived of a fair opportunity to recover its just and equitable share of the natural gas from the Tubb Gas Pool. The formation of the proposed gas proration unit will protect correlative rights and will not cause, but will prevent waste.

A plat is attached hereto which indicated the location of the proposed gas proration unit, the well, and surrounding tracts. A copy of this application with the schematic drawing and plat has been sent by registered mail to each of the operators on the attached mailing list.

The Ohio therefore requests that you grant an exception to the special rules and regulations for the Tubb Gas Pool, that the location of said unit be approved, that this application be granted, and that the proposed non-standard gas proration unit be designated and formed by you without further notice or hearing and pursuant to the provisions of the applicable rules and regulations, upon the expiration of thirty (30) days from this date.

Each and all of the foregoing statements are true and correct.
