Dear Mr. Porter:

The Ohio Oil Company respectfully requests that you grant this application for authority to dually complete its H. H. Turner Well No. 3, located 1980' FSL and 330' FEL, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E. The H. H. Turner Well No. 3 was originally completed on October 1, 1953, as an oil well producing from the Haro Oil Pool. In June, 1956, the well was plugged back and recompleted as a single completion gas well producing from the Blinobry Gas Pool. The Ohio Oil Company now desires to dually complete the well in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tubb Gas Pool through tubing and gas from the Blinobry Gas Pool through the production casing annulus. Ohio intends to install an efficient packer between the two zones and to perform the completion so as to prevent waste in effect completing the well as attached. Subsequent to the completion, it is present to the Commission data showing the initial completion, the cost of well as plans for future testing which will be more regular. It is further noted that waste is not occurring in either reservoir.

The Ohio Oil Company further respectfully requests that you grant this application for the approval of the unorthodox location of the non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the N/2 of SE/4, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, Tubb Gas Pool, Lee County, New Mexico. The Ohio Oil Company has leased the entire acreage included in proposed gas proration unit, and the well to be dually completed in the Blinobry and Tubb Gas Pools.

New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order #3L-33, dated May 20, 1955, approved an unorthodox gas unit location for the T. H. Turner well No. 2, dated 1980' PSL and 330' PGL, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, Blinberry Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico; and New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order NSP-268, dated May 29, 1956, approved an unorthodox non-standard gas production unit in the Blinberry Gas Pool consisting of the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4, Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

All acreage included in the proposed gas production unit is reasonably presumed to be productive of gas from the Tubb Gas Pool. It is impractical to pool the Ohio household estate with adjoining acreage. Unless the proposed gas production unit is formed, Ohio will be deprived of a fair opportunity to recover its just and equitable share of the natural gas from the Tubb Gas Pool. The formation of the proposed gas production unit will protect correlative rights and will not cause, but will prevent waste.

A plot is attached hereto which indicates the location of the proposed gas production unit, the wells, and surrounding tracts. A copy of this application with the schematic drawing and plot has been sent by registered mail to each of the operators on the attached mailing list.

The Ohio therefore requests that you grant an exception to the special rules and regulations for the Tubb Gas Pool, that the location of said unit be approved, that this application be granted, and that the proposed non-standard gas production unit be designated and formed by you without further notice or hearing and pursuant to the provisions of the applicable rules and regulations, upon the expiration of THIRTY (30) days from this date.

Each and all of the foregoing statements are true and correct.
