APPLICATION OF THE TEXAS COMPANY FOR APPROVAL OF A NON-STANDARD PRORATION UNIT EUMONT GAS POOL LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Gentlemen:

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Could When seemed allower ble to have beginning The Texas Company hereby makes application for a 317-acre non-standard proration unit comprising the N/2 of Section 18, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, to be assigned to its Keohane Unit Well No. 1, which produces from the Eumont Gas Pool, and, in support thereof, states the following:

The Texas Company is the owner and operator of the Keohane Unit Well No. 1, which is located at Position "C," 660 feet from the North Line and 2200 feet from the West Line, Section 18, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The location of this well is indicated on the attached plat.

The Texas Company's Keohane Unit Well No. 1 was completed April 14, 1955, in the open hole interval from 3500-3700 feet in the Queen formation, which is included in the vertical delineation of the Eumont Gas Pool. Said well had an initial open flow potential of 4830 MCF per day, and its present capacity is 6000+ MCF per day.

A communization agreement has been executed by all of the working interest owners of acreage within the N/2 of Section 18. This communization agreement will extend the present 159-acre proration unit, outlined in yellow on the attached plat, assigned to the Keohane Unit Well No. 1 to include the S/2 of the N/2 of Section 18, which is under lease to Gulf Oil Corporation. The resulting 317-acre non-standard proration

unit is shown outlined in red on the attached plat.

- The proposed non-standard proration unit meets the requirements in Rule 5(b) of Order R-520 in that: (a) It is comprised of contiguous 4/4 sections. (b) All of the proposed non-standard proration unit lies within a governmental section. (c) All of the acreage within the proposed non-standard proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Eumont Gas Pool. (d) Neither the length nor the width of the proposed unit exceeds 5280 feet.
- 5. All operators as covered by Paragraph 5, Rule 5(b) of Order R-520 are notified of this application by copy hereof through registered mail, and a letter of waiver covering the granting of the proposed non-standard proration unit is requested from each.

Based on the facts recited above, The Texas Company respectfully requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission approve administratively the non-standard proration unit described above.
