Reference is made to your application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinbry Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Hinton Well No. 5 located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of said Section 12.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3 (B), of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinbry Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-610, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 120 acres.


