Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM,  
Section 25: SW/4  
Section 26: S/2 SE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Federal Fopeano Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 SW/4 of said Section 25.

Inasmuch as you enclosed waivers from the offset operators agreeing to the formation of the proposed unit, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool as set forth in Order R-520, based upon the unit size of 240 acres.
