Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 60-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Section 23: SW/4 NE/4; N/2 of the SE/4 of the NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your F. Stuart Well No. 1, located 1650 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line of said Section 23.
