Company for 120-acre Non-Standard
Gas Proration Unit, Blinebry Pool,
Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Now comes The Ohio Oil Company, an Ohio corporation, with
offices at Hobbs, New Mexico, who respectfully requests
administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration
unit in exception to Rule 5 (A) of Order No. R-610 per-
taining to the Blinebry Gas Pool.

Applicant further states and deposes the following:

1. Applicant is the operator of the oil & gas rights
under all of the SE/4 of Sec. 15 T21S R37E, NMPM,
Lea County, New Mexico, said lease comprising 160
acres, more or less, with all mineral rights therein
having been communitized by operating agreement and
being known as The Ohio Oil Company's L. G. Warlick "C"
Lease.

2. Applicant completed their L. G. Warlick "C" Well No.2 on November 19, 1953, as a Drinkard (Oil)/Blinebry (Gas) dual as authorized by Order DC-14 at a location 1980' FEL & 660' FSL, Sec. 15 T21S R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Blinebry gas perms 5527'-5752', are within the vertical limits of the Blinebry Gas Pool and since completion, the gas and liquid characteristics have been consistently within the limitations as set by Rule 18, Order No. R-610 B.

3. On May 15, 1960 applicant recompleted their L. G. Warlick "C" Well No. 9 located 990' FSL & FEL Sec. 15 T21S R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, from the Brunson Pool to the Blinebry Oil Pool thru 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing perms, 5729'-5778'. On initial potential test, May 15, 1960, the Blinebry oil zone flowed 57.95 BO & no water in 8 hours at rate of 174 BOPD thru a 13/64" choke with GOR 3559:1. Gravity crude 37.8°. API @ 60° F.

4. Rule 6 of Order No. R-610 states: "Acreage dedicated to a gas well in the Blinebry Gas Pool shall not be simultaneously dedicated to an oil well in the Blinebry Oil Pool". Accordingly, applicant respectfully requests that the N/2 of the SE/4 and the SW/4 of the SE/4 of Sec.15 T21S R37E, being 120 acres, more or less, be designated as a non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool and assigned to the Blinebry gas zone in The Ohio Oil Company's L. G. Warlick "C" Well No. 2.

5. Creating of the above proposed non-standard gas proration unit is in the interest of conservation and will protect correlative rights.

6. A plat showing the said Ohio Oil Company's L. G. Warlick "C" Lease and all wells thereon, the acreage to be dedicated, and offset ownership is attached hereto.




