Texas Pacific Coal and Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under provisions of rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool of Order No. R-520 for the formation of a 240 acre non-standard gas proration unit for its State of New Mexico "A" A/c-1, Well No. 12, located 660 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the east line of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico in the Jalmat Gas Pool; and in support of this request states:

1. The proposed non-standard unit will consist of the SE/4 and the S/2 of the NE/4 of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 36 East.
2. The entire unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
3. The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
4. Copies of this application have been furnished all operators within 1500 feet of this well.
