

Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. hereby makes application for approval of a 160acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont (Gas) Pool, comprised of the SE/4 of Section 11, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, with the C. H. Weir "B" Well No. 4 as the unit well, and in support thereof states the following:

1. TEXACO Inc. is owner and operator of the C. H. Weir "B" Lease comprising 320 acres covering the E/2 of Section 11, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat. The C. H. Weir "B" Well No. 3 is the Eumont (Gas) Unit Well for the N/2 of this 320-acre lease.

2. TEXACO Inc. is owner and operator of the C. H. Weir "B" Well No. 4 located in Unit I, 2044 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 11, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Locating the well 64 feet north of the normal 1980 feet from the south line was necessary because of a Warren Petroleum Corporation Pump Station Installation in the area. The well was recently completed in the Eumont (Gas) Pool, and TEXACO Inc. proposes that the SE/4 of Section 11 be established as a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont (Gas) Pool with this well as the unit well.

3. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (c) of Order No. 1670, Eumont (Gas) Pool, as follows:

(1) The proposed non-standard proration unit consists of less acreage than a standard proration unit.

(2) The unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.

(3) The unit lies wholly within a governmental section.

(4) The entire unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Eumont (Gas) Pool.

(5) The length or width of the unit does not exceed 5280 feet.

(6) By copy of this letter of application, alloperators owning interests in the section in which the unit is located and all operators owning interests within 1500 feet of the unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of TEXACO Inc. to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. Offset operators notified are: Continental Oil Company, P. O. Box 68, Eunice, New Mexico; Schermerhorn Oil Corporation, P. O. Box 1027, Odessa, Texas; and Southwest Production Company, 3108 Southland Center, Dallas, Texas.

Based upon the facts recited above, TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission approve administratively the non-standard gas proration unit described above.

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
