Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5(c) of the General Rules and Regulations for provated gas pools of Southeast New Mexico of Order No. R-1670 for the reduction of the presently approved 160-acre unit to an 80-acre non-standard gas promation unit consisting of the 5/2 of SE/4 of Section 1, Township 22 South, Pange 36 Frat, for its Lockhart B-1 No. 6 well located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 1, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, MIPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5(c) in all respects as follows:

- 1. Said proposed unit consists of less than 640 acres.
- 2. Said proposed non-standard gas provation unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- 3. Said proposed non-standard gas proretion unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 4. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas from the Eumonit Pool.
- 5. The length or width of said unit does not a seed 5,280 feet.
- 6. Copies of this application have been Carmished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 of said well, as required by the provisions of said Bala 5(c).

A plat is rttsched hereto showed to the boot of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the locabler of the Me. I will aid other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.

The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.


