Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5(c) of the General Rules and Regulations for prorated gas pools of Southeast New Mexico of Order No. R-1670 for the reduction of the presently approved 160-acre unit to an 80-acre non-standard gas production unit consisting of the S/2 of SE/4 of Section 1, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, for its Lockhart B-1 No. 6 well located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 1, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5(c) in all respects as follows:

1. Said proposed unit consists of less than 640 acres.
2. Said proposed non-standard gas production unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
3. Said proposed non-standard gas production unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. The entire proposed non-standard gas production unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas from the Eumont Pool.
5. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
6. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 2,500' of said well, as required by the provisions of said Rule 5(c).

A plot is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the No. 6 well and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.

The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission enter an order approving the non-standard gas proration unit for Continental Oil Company's Lockhart B-1 No. 6 well as described above.

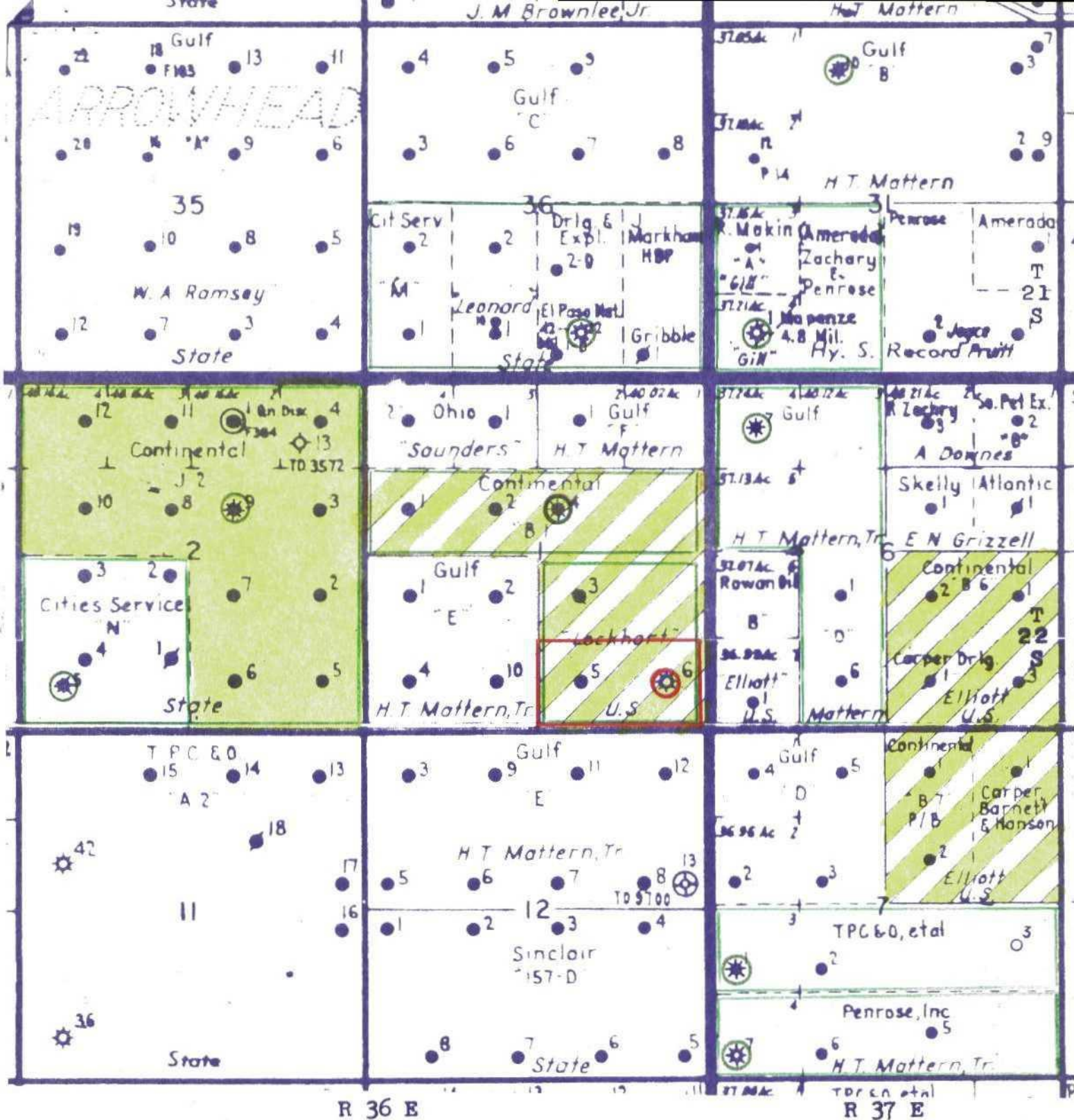
