We respectfully submit this application for and request approval of a 40 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinsbry Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST
SE/4 of the NE/4, Section 9

This unit shall be assigned to our Southland Royalty Company "A" Well No. 6 located 1980' from the North and 660' from the East Lines and in the SE/4 of the NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 9, T-21S, R-37E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The recent completion of our Southland Royalty Company "A" Well No. 7 located in the NE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 9, T-21S, R-37E, occasioned this 40 acre non-standard proration unit.

In support of our request for exception approval without notice and hearing to Rule 5 (A) of Order R-1670, the following is submitted:

1. This application letter is submitted in triplicate.
2. The non-standard gas proration unit
 - (a) consists of a single quarter-quarter section;
 - (b) lies wholly within a single governmental section;
 - (c) may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas;
 - (d) length or width of proration unit does not exceed 2640';
 - (e) lies within the horizontal limits of the Blinsbry Gas Pool.

3. By registered mail, copies of this letter are being furnished all offset operators notifying that application is being made for a non-standard proration unit.
4. A plat showing acreage to be dedicated, well location and offset ownership is attached.



On September 10, 1962, this office received the above application requesting administrative approval of a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool comprising the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 9, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

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This application was placed in our suspense file pending the 30-day waiting period in which offset operators may file objections to granting the application.
