Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
Section 22: N/2 SW/4 and SW/4 SW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Turner Well No. 12, located 2065 feet from the South line and 1700 feet from the West line of said Section 22.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Blinebry Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 120 acres.

This order shall be effective August 1, 1964, the date your Turner Well No. 12 was reclassified as a Blinebry gas well.
