Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests Administrative approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas promation unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool, covering the SW/4 and W/2 NW/4 Section 4-225-36E, Lea County, New Mexico. This non-standard unit is to be attributed to the J. F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 7 located 1,980 feet from the south and west lines of this Section 4. The attached plat shows this non-standard unit outlined in red.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- Applicant's J. F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 7 is dually completed in the South Emnice Oil and Jalmat Gas Pools. Order No. R-1770 approved three non-standard gas proration units, one of which was a 160-acre unit covering the SW/4 of Section 4, to be attributed to the J. F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 7.
- (2) Applicant's J. F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 5 located in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 4 was dually completed in the Jalmat and South Eunice Oil Pocls; however, has recently been reclassified from a Jalmat Oil Well to a Jalmat Gas Well. The Jalmat gas zone will be shut-in and since there are now no Jalmat oil wells in the W/2 NW/4 it is proposed to attribute this 80 acres to Well No. 7 to form the non-standard 240-acre gas proration unit.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas promation unit consists of contiguous quarterquarter sections or lots.
- (4) The proposed non-standard gas provation unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (5) The entire non-standard unit is reasonably presumed to be gas productive in the Jalmat Gas Pool.



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- (6) The length or width of the proposed non-standard unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- (7) Applicant owns all the leasehold interest in the section in which the proposed non-standard unit is located and within 1,500 feet of the unit well.


